Ballet Levels 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5

Pointe & PBT* Classes:

Black or blue leotard
Pink Tights (convertible tights for PBT)
Shoes:
Pink ballet slippers for technique classes
Pointe shoes for pointe classes
Bare feet for PBT
Hair: Bun for all ballet classes
PBT: low ponytail or high-top knot bun

Lyrical

Jazz, Street Jazz

Leaps & Turns:

Black or blue half top or leotard
Black boy shorts
Shoes: Pirouette
Hair: Ponytail

Creative Combo - Ballet/Tap:

Black or blue leotard
Pink Tights
Shoes: Pink ballet slippers & black tap shoes
Hair: Bun

Stretch & Tricks:

Black or blue half top or leotard
Black boy shorts or leggings/sweatpants
Hair: Ponytail

Princess Dance:

Black, blue or pink leotard (plain or with attached skirt)
Pink Tights
Shoes: Pink ballet slippers
Any color skirt (optional)
Hair: pulled back, bun or ponytail
Last class of each month – DRESS UP in the theme!

Tap:

Black or blue half top or leotard
Black boy shorts
Shoes: any style tap shoe

Hip Hop:

Anything goes (Keep it funky)
Street shoes or sneakers



Boys: All Classes

Black or white tank top or t-shirt
Black or grey shorts or sweatpants
Tights may be worn for ballet classes but not required
Ballet classes require: Black ballet slippers
